

ORDINANCE # 111

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTFALL,
PIKE COUNTY, AMENDING ORDINANCE #76-1 KNOWN
AS THE "WESTFALL TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE
OF 1990" TO AMEND SECTION 2.2 THEREOF TO CLARIFY
THE DEFINITION OF 'STRUCTURE'.

Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township,
Pike County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1: AMENDMENT – Ordinance # 76-1, adopted the 27th day of December
1990, being the "Westfall Township Zoning Ordinance of 1990" is hereby amended
as follows:

Section 2.2 DEFINITIONS is hereby amended to amend the
definition of "structure" to read as follows:

Structure - Any combination of materials forming a unit, which
requires location in or on the ground or which is attached to
something having location on the ground. The term "structure" shall
include signs, fences, walls, towers, swimming pools, porches,
garages, and similar structures but shall specifically exclude
components of individual onlot sewage disposal systems.

Section II: REPEALER - Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with
this Ordinance be, and the same is hereby repealed in so far as the same is
inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section III: EFFECTIVE DATE – This Ordinance shall become effective 5 days
following adoption by the Board of Supervisors.

This Ordinance is duly ordained and enacted into Law this 4th day of June, 2002 at a duly and legally convened meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, after a public meeting thereon having been held on the 29th day of May, 2002.
