

ORDINANCE NO. 129

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTFALL, COUNTY OF PIKE SETTING  
COMPENSATION FOR THE SUPERVISORS OF WESTFALL TOWNSHIP**

**BE IT ORDAINED** that the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township, County of Pike, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania do hereby adopt the following:

**WHEREAS**, the general assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted legislation setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of Supervisors of Townships of the Second Class (53 P. S. Section 65606 and hereinafter "Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, said Act provides the Supervisors of Townships having a population of not more than 4,999 residents may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875.00 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly by said Act has authorized the Boards of Supervisors of various Townships of the Second Class within the Commonwealth to determine the compensation of Supervisors thereof subject to the limitations set forth in the said Act.

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:


1. Each Supervisor of Westfall Township, Pike County, elected or appointed to said office on or after the effective date of this Ordinance shall receive compensation for serving in said capacity in the amount of \$1,875.00 annually.
2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly or quarterly installments.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective on December 31, 2007.
4. Any Ordinances of the said Township of Westfall. Pike County inconsistent herewith be and are hereby expressly repealed.

ORDAINED and ADOPTED this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2007 at a duly convened meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County.
