

ORDINANCE #12 - A

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTFALL, COUNTY OF PIKE AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR STREET LIGHTING SERVICE WITH PIKE COUNTY LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY ON CEMETERY ROAD, A TOWNSHIP ROAD, FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS, AND TO ASSESS THE COST AND EXPENSE OF MAINTENANCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, a petition of the owners of a majority of the lineal feet frontage on Cemetery Road, a public township road, extends from public highway U.S. Route No. 6 to the Delaware River, all in Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, was presented to the Supervisors of the Township of Westfall on September 6, 1960 requesting the Township to enter into a contract with an electric company to light and illuminate said road.

THEREFORE, Be it enacted and ordained by the Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION I

That the Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike and State of Pennsylvania shall enter into a five (5) year contract with the Pike County Light and Power Company to light and illuminate a public Township road known as Cemetery Road which extends from the Public Highway, U.S. Route No. 6 to the Delaware River.

SECTION II

That the Township Supervisors shall annually assess or cause to be assessed the cost and expense of the maintenance of said lights, pursuant to the authority contained in Article VII of Section 702 of the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L.
