WESTFALL TOWNSHIP PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NUMBER 159

An Ordinance Amending the Westfall Township Ordinance No. 31, prescribing traffic and parking regulations adopted November 25, 1974 to reflect a change in time provision in Section Two and the penalty provision in Section Seven.

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. 66506, and 66601, the Board of Supervisors may make and adopt any Ordinances, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations not inconsistent with or restrained by the Constitution and Laws of this Commonwealth necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Township and its finances and the maintenance of peace, good government, health and welfare of the Township and its citizens, trade, commerce and manufactures;

WHEREAS, under or pursuant to the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. 10609, before voting on the enactment of an amendment, the Board of Supervisors shall hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to public notice; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED IN ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania;

- 1. The preceding Whereas Clauses are hereby incorporated as the same or set forth at length herein;
- 2. The Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

FROM: Section Two: Parking is hereby prohibited on all streets of the Township at any and all times between the hours of 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM during the period from November 1 of each year to April 1 of the following year.

TO: Section Two: Parking is hereby prohibited on all streets of the Township at any and all times between the hours of 11 PM to 6 AM during the period from November 1 each year to April 1 of the following year and during any snowstorm.

From: Section Seven: Any person who shall violate any provisions or this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than two (\$2.00) Dollars or more than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and cost of prosecution; and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.

To: <u>Section Seven</u> : Any person who shall violate any provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars and cost of prosecution.
