

Westfall Township

Ordinance No. 161

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 53 P.S. Section 66506 of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may make and adopt any ordinance, by-laws, rules and regulations not inconsistent with or restrained by the Constitution and laws of the Commonwealth necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Township and its finances and the maintenance of peace, good government, health, welfare of the Township and its citizens, trade, commerce and manufacturers;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 53 P.S. Section 66512(d) of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may contract with any insurance company, non-profit hospitalization corporation or non-profit medical service corporation to insure its Supervisors and employees and their dependents under a policy or policies of group insurance covering life, health, hospitalization, medical service or accident insurance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 53 P.S. Section 66512(e) of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may contract with any insurance company for the pensioning of employees and may pay part or all of the pensions or charges for group pension or annuity plans;

WHEREAS, Westfall Township maintains a pension plan offered through the Pennsylvania Municipalities Pension Trust ("pension trust") offered through the trustees' insurance fund ("health trust");

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of Westfall, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. The trustees of the pension trust and health trust have submitted proposed changes to the trust documents.

SECTION 2. A majority of members of the pension trust and health trust have approved said changes to be effective as of October 15, 2014.


SECTION 3. The Supervisors find that the changes do not affect current coverage and are otherwise in the best interest of the Township Supervisors and employees.

SECTION 4. The Supervisors agree with the proposed changes and the Township shall participate in the trust to assure compliance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act and the Amended Trust Agreements.
