Ordinance No. 165

AN ORDINANCE OF WESTFALL TOWNSHIP, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 158, CITED AS THE WESTFALL TOWNSHIP AMUSEMENT TAX ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, Westfall Township Supervisors, Pike County, Pennsylvania, hereby adopt the following Ordinance.

Section 1: The Westfall Township Supervisors have previously adopted Ordinance No. 158 cited as the Westfall Township Amusement Tax Ordinance under and pursuant to the authority granted by the "Local Tax Enabling Act" 53 P.S. 6924.101 *et seq.* having previously determined that an amusement tax would be in the best interest of the common good as to increase general revenues within the Township for purposes of providing residents with essential services.


Section 2: The Westfall Township Supervisors, following the enactment of said Ordinance, have determined that the taxes generated were nominal and did not substantially increase general revenues with the Township for purposes of providing residents with essential services.

Section 3: Based upon the aforementioned findings, the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township hereby repeal Ordinance No. 158 cited as the Westfall Township Amusement Tax Ordinance.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE – this Ordinance shall become effective this 3rd day of August, 2015.
