

ORDINANCE NO. 17

Amendment to Ordinance No. 16, being an Ordinance regulating trailer coaches and trailer parks within the limits of the Township of Westfall, Pike County, Pennsylvania, for the better protection of health and safety therein; providing for permits for the construction of trailer parks and for their operation and maintenance, and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions thereof.

Be it ordained and enacted, Section 5 of Ordinance 16 is hereby amended by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to be as follows:

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to occupy a trailer outside of a trailer park on any land which in area is less than 22,000 square feet, owned in fee simple by the person occupying the same, and free from any other buildings, and said trailer must be on a permanent foundation of masonry cinder block or concrete with footing at least three and one-half feet below ground level, and all wheels on trailer must be removed. The person shall have 30 days from date trailer is placed on land to complete foundation and remove wheels.

That Ordinance No. 16 is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects, except for the amendment hereto.

That any ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance.
