

WESTFALL TOWNSHIP PIKE COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 180

WHEREAS, the Township of Westfall, Pike County, Pennsylvania, is a Second-Class Township with a population of 2,805 and;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 94 of 2024 setting the parameters for the compensation of Supervisors of various Township classes, with new compensation caps set effective as of December 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS the compensation for Townships with a population of not more than 4,999 has been increased from \$1,875 to a new cap of \$3,145; and

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania is desirous of enacting an ordinance to increase the yearly compensation to \$3,145 per year payable in monthly increments;

NOW THEREFORE, after proper advertisement and hearing, it is HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Township as follows:

- 1 . Each duly elected Supervisor of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania entering office after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation as an elected Township Supervisor in the annual amount of \$3,145;
2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly increments of \$262.00.

Duly enacted and ordained this 2nd day of June 2025 by the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania in lawful session duly assembled and advertised.

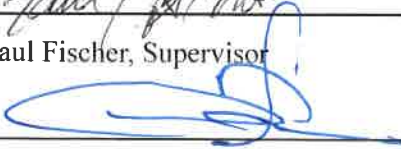

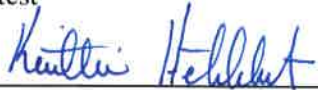
