

ORDINANCE NO. 2.

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with the Department of Water of the Borough of Matamoras for installing fire hydrants on Delaware Drive, Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and providing for the assessment to the property owners benefited thereby for the cost of the same.

Section 1. Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, That the Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, enter into a contract with the Department of Water of the Borough of Matamoras, Pike County, Pennsylvania, for the installing of fire hydrants along Delaware Drive in Westfall Township at locations designated between the boundary line of the said Borough of Matamoras and Westfall Township, and the property now owned by Carlton Shay, and for the furnishing of water by the said Borough of Matamoras to the said hydrants for fire protection.

Section 2. That the said Supervisors shall levy, for the acquisition of said water system for the maintenance of such fire hydrants, an annual tax upon the property abutting upon said Delaware Drive and upon properties within six hundred feet of any fire hydrant in the district benefited thereby, based upon the assessment for county purposes.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 2

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with the Department of Water of the Borough of Matamoras for installing fire hydrants on Delaware Drive, Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and providing for the assessment to the property owners benefited thereby for the cost of the same.

Section 1. Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, That the Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, enter into a contract with the Department of Water of the Borough of Matamoras, Pike County, Pennsylvania, for the installing of fire hydrants along Delaware Drive in Westfall Township at locations designated between the bound-

dary line of the said Borough of Matamoras and Westfall Township, and the property now owned by Carlton Shay, and for the furnishing of water by the said Borough of Matamoras to the said hydrants for fire protection.

Section 2. That the said Supervisors shall levy for the acquisition of said water system for the maintenance of such fire hydrants, an annual tax upon the property abutting upon said Delaware Drive and upon properties within six hundred feet of any fire hydrant in the district benefited thereby, based upon the assessment for county purposes.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
