

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT
OF ONE OR MORE POLICEMEN IN THE TOWNSHIP
OF WESTFALL.

The Township of Westfall ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That whereas a petition was presented to the Supervisors of Westfall Township, with more than twenty-five registered electors or taxpayers of the Township, representing that the safety of the citizens and the security of property make it necessary for the appointment of one or more policemen, the supervisors shall appoint one or more registered electors who shall be residents of the Commonwealth, to act as policemen, and to serve at the will of the supervisors.

SECTION 2. The supervisors shall fix the number of policemen, the compensation of said policemen, and shall limit the term of service of said policemen as it may deem proper.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its approval as provided by law.
