

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SPECIFICATIONS
FOR PROPOSED STREETS OR ROADWAYS IN WESTFALL
TOWNSHIP, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Township of Westfall Supervisors at a duly and legally convened meeting hereby ordain as follows:

1. All streets or roadways shall have a minimum right of way of fifty (50) feet in width, exclusive of sidewalks and curbs.
2. All streets or roadways shall have a minimum of six (6) inches of shale or gravel in depth, and compressed and rolled to a minimum width of thirty three (33) feet, and compressed or rolled from curb to curb.
3. All streets or roadways shall have a finished surface width of not less than twenty (20) feet. The finished surface shall be constructed with two applications of stone and Pennsylvania Department of Highways standard road oil material as follows:
 - (A) First application shall include a requirement of thirty (30) pounds of 2 B Stone to the square yard and three quarters (3/4) gallons of standard road oil material to the square yard applied and rolled to completion.
 - (B) Second application shall include a requirement of twenty pounds of 1 B stone to the square yard and three tenths (3/10) gallons of standard road oil material to the square yard applied and rolled to completion.

4. All streets or roadways shall be constructed with proper drainage subject to the inspection and approval of the Supervisors.

5. All streets or roadways shall be inspected and approved by the Supervisors and Township District Engineer upon the completion of the construction.

Enacted and ordained by the Township of Westfall into an ordinance this 17th day of May, 1967.
