

ORDINANCE NO. 26

Amendment to Ordinance No. 25, being an Ordinance requiring that a permit be obtained before the construction of any building within the Township of Westfall, or the construction of any addition to any existing building therein, requiring that plans and specifications be submitted, setting forth building requirements, and prescribing penalties for violation:

Be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that Section 4 a of Ordinance No. 25 is hereby amended to be as follows:

Section 4 a. No building shall be located less than 25 feet from the edge or side of the road right-of-way facing the street.

That Ordinance No. 25 is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects, except for the amendment hereto.

That any ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance.
