WESTFALL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WESTFALL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 31- #
Be it ordained by the Township of Westfall, County of
Pike, State of Pennsylvania, as follows:

- I A. Paragraph C. is added to Part V Fees of Westfall
 Township Ordinance No. 31 to read as follows:
 - C. A fee of ten (\$10.00) dollars shall be charged for each test pit inspection by the Sewage Enforcement officer whenever a request for a test pit inspection is not accompanied by an application for a permit.
 - B. Paragraph D is added to Part V Fees of Westfall
 Township Ordinance No. 31 to read as follows:
 - D. Whenever a permit expires a re-issuance fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars shall be charged for a new permit.
 - C. Paragraph E is added to Part V Fees of Westfall Township Ordinance No. 314to read as follows:
 - E. A fee of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) dollars will be charged for an application for a holding tank permit. A holding tank permit is only valid for the calendar year of its issuance.
- II If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance be held invalid, the validity thereof shall not effect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

- III Any one in violation of any provision of this
 Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and
 be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred
 (\$100.00) dollars not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00)
 Dollars and costs per offense. Everyday in which the
 said violator fails to comply with the provisions
 of this Ordinance shall constitute a new and seperate
 offense.
- IV Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to affect, modify, amend or repeal any provision of the Act of June 22, 1973 (Act. No. 394) or the amendments thereto.

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of adoption.
