ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ANNUAL COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR THE SUPERVISORS OF WESTFALL TOWNSHIP

Whereas the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

Whereas said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of One (1) to Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-nine (4999) persons shall be compensated in an amount not to One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars, and

Whereas the population of Westfall Township is approximately One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-Five (1,825) persons, and

Whereas the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the Act, and

Whereas it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Westfall Township to set compensation for supervisors on a per meeting basis and within the limitations of Act 68.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Westfall Township, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as hereinafter provided:

- 1. Each supervisor of Westfall Township elected or appointed to office on or after November 5, 1985, shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the board of supervisors at the rate of thirty (\$30.00) dollars for each meeting attended by such supervisors.
- 2. No supervisor shall receive annual compensation under this ordiannce in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in Act 68 for supervisors of townships within the appropriate population category.
- 3. No supervisor shall be compensated for attending any meetings of the board of supervisors in excess of fifty (50) meetings per year;

such absences of compensation shall not negate or in any way affect such supervisor's duty or obligation to attend such uncompensated meetings.

- 4. Such compensation shall be paid in quarterly installments.
- 5. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of its adoption.
- 6. All ordinances, and parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
