AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP  
OF WESTFALL, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF WESTFALL AS FOLLOWS:

A. Definitions and Interpretations

1. Words and phrases, when used herein shall have the meanings ascribed them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force, or as hereinafter amended, enacted, or reenacted, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning.
2. The singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

B. Speed Limits Established

The maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along Old Pond Drive (Twp. Rt. 456) and Heaters Hill (Twp. Rt. 447) is hereby established at thirty (30) miles per hour.

C. Parking Regulation

No person shall park a vehicle at anytime upon the Service Road portion of Township Route 452 as follows:

1. On the east side of the Service Road, for a distance of seventy-five (75) feet, as a vehicle is traveling in a southerly direction from a point where the southerly side of Rose Land intersects with the easterly side of the Service Road.
2. On the West side of the Service Road, for a distance of seventy five (75) feet, directly opposite and across from the no parking area established in paragraph C. 1 above.

D. Stop Intersection

The intersection described below is hereby established as a stop intersection, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position upon the first - named highway as to face traffic approaching the second - named highway in the direction indicated. All vehicles approaching any

such intersection upon the first - named highway; in the direction as indicated in each case, shall come to a full stop, within a reasonable distance, before entering the intersection.

E. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the Ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid provision not been included herein.

F. Repealer

This Ordinance hereby repeals any preceding ordinances, or parts thereof, that may be inconsistent herewith.

G. Violations and Penalties

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense, and shall be liable to a penalty of not more than fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution.
