

ORDINANCE NO. 67-1

An Ordinance amending the Ordinance providing for the Establishment and Regulation of a Pension Plan for the full-time Police Employees of the Township of Westfall.

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED as follows:

ARTICLE I:

The Ordinance known as Ordinance No. 67, being entitled an Ordinance providing for the Establishment and Regulation of a Police Pension Plan for full-time Police Employees of Westfall Township, enacted on December 6, 1988 is hereby amended as follows:

Add to Article II.

- 2.13 Investment: Investment shall mean the purchase, sale, acquisition, holding, transfer, conversion, or otherwise dealing in money, securities, or property of each and every nature whatsoever, whether real, personal or mixed for the purpose of and with the intent to generate profit, interest or gain.

ARTICLE II

Except as herein amended, the aforesaid Ordinance No. 67 is hereby ratified and confirmed in each and every of its provisions.
