

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14
ADOPTED JUNE 5, 1962, AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE TOWN-
SHIP PLANNING COMMISSION FROM FIVE (5) TO
SEVEN (7) MEMBERS.

The Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION I. The aforesaid Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

The Planning Commission shall consist of Seven (7) members who shall be appointed by the Supervisors and shall serve without compensation, except that they shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in carrying out their commission duties. The terms of office of the members shall be for Four (4) years and shall be fixed so that no more than Two (2) members shall be reappointed or replaced during any calendar year. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if a vacancy shall occur otherwise and by expiration of term of office of the member, the Board of Supervisors shall fill such vacancy by appointment thereto for the unexpired term of the member vacating office. All members of the said Commission shall reside within and be residents of the Township.

SECTION II. Nothing in this Ordinance shall effect or be deemed to effect the term of office of any member of the said Planning Commission in office on the date of the adoption hereof.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall become effective Five (5) days after the date of its adoption by the Township Board of Supervisors.

SECTION IV. Except as herein amended, the aforesaid Ordinance is hereby re-enacted, ratified and confirmed in its entirety.

This Ordinance is hereby enacted and ordained into law this 6th day of March, 1990, pursuant to the authorities granted to the Township Board of Supervisors under the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, as re-enacted December 21, 1988, P. L. 1329, No. 170, §2:53 P.S. §101 et seq, effective the 6 day of March, 1990.
