ORDINANCE NO. 9.

An Ordinance to Vacate a Portion of Route No. 432 in Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, in the Judgment of the Supervisors of Westfall Township it is necessary for the public convenience to vacate a portion of Route No. 432 in Westfall Township, as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, ten days' written notice was given by the said Supervisors to all property owners affected thereby, that a hearing would be held on March 1, 1955; and

WHEREAS, after said hearing, and a consideration of the matter the supervisors of Westfall Township did unanimously, on March 1, 1955 resolve that the hereinafter described portion of said public Route No. 432 had become useless, inconvenient and burdensome, and that its vacation was necessary for the public convenience; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Westfall Township have filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for Pike County, duplicate copies of their report and a draft of that portion of Route 432 to be vacated, all of which was done in accordance with the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. That pursuant to the proceedings set forth in the preamble hereof, the following portion of Route No. 432 in Westfall Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, be and is hereby vacated:

BEGINNING at intersection of Route 434 and Route 432; thence in a generally southerly direction along Route 432 through lands of Bear Camp Club to a point about 50 feet from the northwest corner of Bear Camp, being a total length of 0.2 miles.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for the County of Pike.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
