ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR "STOP" INTERSECTIONS AND THE ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF "STOP" SIGNS AT SUCH INTERSECTIONS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTFALL, COUNTY OF PIKE AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Westfall, County of Pike, as follows:

SECTION 1. Short Title: This Ordinance shall be known as the "Westfall Township Stop Sign Ordinance of 1999."

SECTION 2. Definitions: In this Ordinance, the terms used shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the "Vehicle Code" of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, §1; 75 Pa.C.S.A. 101 et seq., as amended.

SECTION 3. Stop Intersections: The entrances to the following named streets, roads or avenues in the Township of Westfall, County of Pike, are hereby designated as stop intersections:

- A. Maple Avenue at its intersections with Cuddeback Street.
- B. Maple Avenue at its intersections with Margaret Street.
- C. Maple Avenue at its intersections with Graham Street.
- D. Margaret Street at its intersection with 10th Street.
- E. Graham Street at its intersection with 10th Street.
- F. Bertha Street at its intersection with 10th Street.

SECTION 4. Stop Signs: There shall be erected and maintained by the Township of Westfall at the "Stop Intersections", as set forth in Section 3 hereof, official stop signs.

SECTION 5. Severability: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, the illegality or invalidity shall not

SECTION 5. Severability: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, the illegality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision not been included herein.

SECTION 6. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
